

Greening our Outdoor Space

This year we've had a couple of projects involving our green outdoor space:

Olivia Williams from Warwickshire Wildlife Trust helped us plant a native hedgerow (Hawthorn, Field Maple, Blackthorn and Hazel) along the fence boundary with the adjacent field. Olivia also helped us plant a wildflower strip (with yellow rattle and other cornfield species such as poppy) along the other fence boundaries with School Lane and the main road. Both these projects will enhance the wildlife and biodiversity of our green space and surrounding areas. Farm Services Ltd have installed a drainage scheme in the field to help improve the condition of the field following rain, especially with the increasing number of intense storms we're experiencing as part of our changing climate. We received a grant from the Community Lottery Fund to help towards the cost of the work. We've also taken the opportunity to level out some areas and reseed to give us an even better green outdoor space.
